In order to enjoy your trip with peace of mind, you need to purchase private medical insurance* that provides sufficient coverage.
*Including travel insurance that covers medical expenses during your stay.

- 1** Medical expenses may be very high depending on the symptoms, but you'll be prepared for those unexpected charges.
- 2** If your insurance covers interpreting services, you'll be able to describe your symptoms accurately at the hospital, even if you can't speak Japanese.
- 3** If your insurance policy includes medical institution referral and arrangement services, you'll be able to get to the appropriate hospital.

Before you leave for Japan, purchase insurance with sufficient coverage and services for medical expenses relating to COVID-19 and other infectious diseases so you can enjoy your trip to the fullest.

*You can also purchase travel insurance from your smartphone or other devices after arriving in Japan. *Be sure to check exactly what your insurance policy covers.
